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


Welcome to Term Two!


How Kakapo home learning Works

While we are unable to meet together in the classroom, we will use Seesaw and Google Drive to connect from home. In our week, there will be opportunities to connect with me and each other.



Well done! You are done for the day!








FOR STUDENTS




If you would like to comment on your classmates work it is important that we are kind and give good feedback.



What does a quality comment look and sound like?

- A comment tells someone what you think of their work.
- It has friendly and kind words.
- Make your comments interesting.
- Ask a question to keep the conversation going.
- Use capital letters at the beginning of sentences and full stops at the end.
- Use descriptive words.
- Use 3 or fewer emojis.


